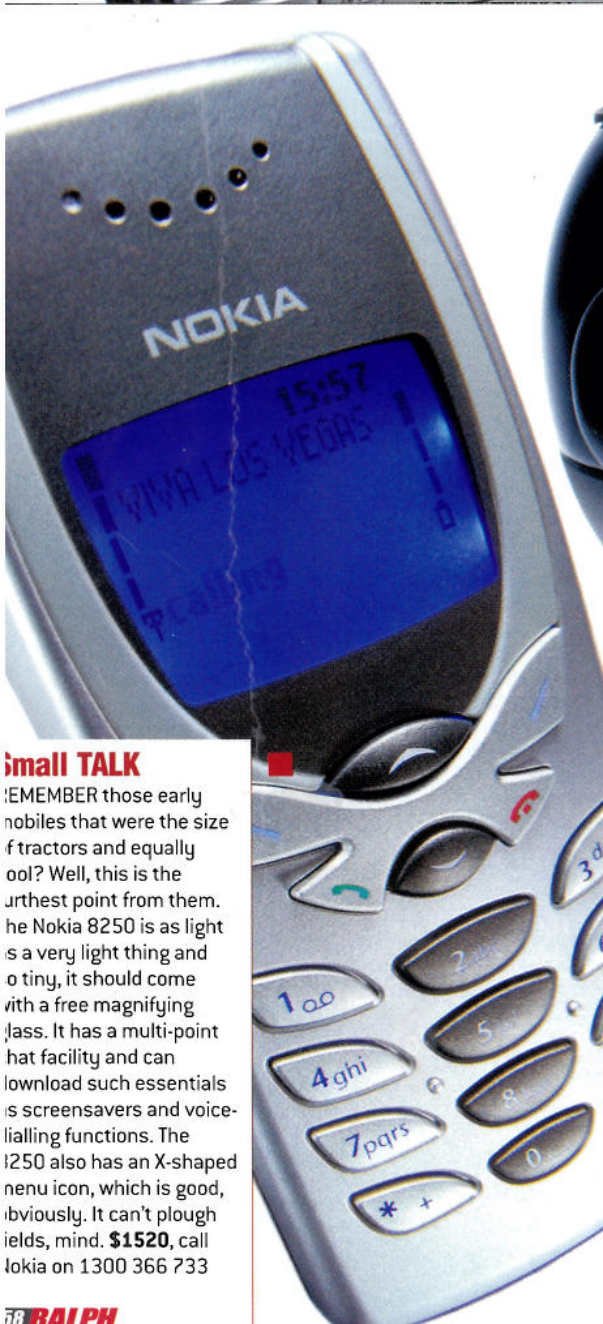

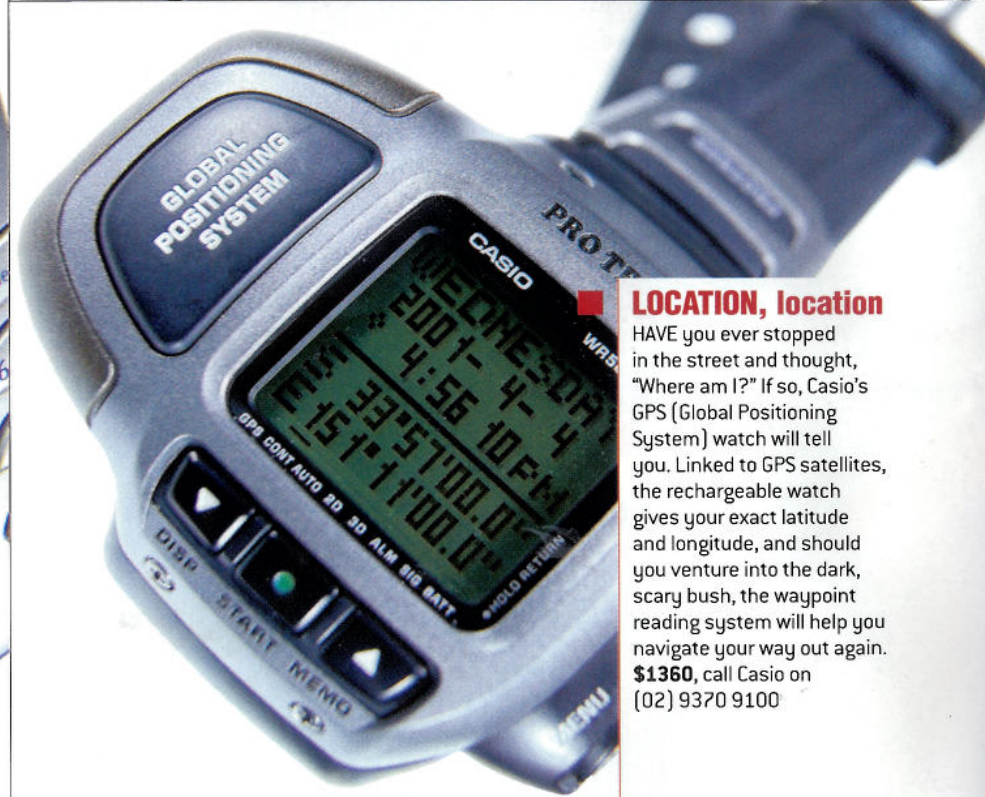
Small TALK
