How did you feel the first time you saw yourself on the teev?

It was weird. They didn't get our background very well. They showed us [Fiona and her partner, Adam] as being the Barbie and Ken, but they didn't show that we'd worked our bums off to get where we are. And that was why we got on the show. But if I start thinking about every little thing being taken the wrong way, I'll end up in a mental asylum.

How did it work with the cameras?

We had a crew each. When I'd get home at five o'clock from work, they'd be waiting at the door for me to walk in. They would stay with us until we went to sleep. Sometimes they'd leave about 12, but as soon as they left, the other cameras switched on. Then we'd be woken up with them at the front door at 6am. Or – they had keys – so they'd walk into our apartment and video us asleep, then wake us up to do a video diary.

They had keys?

Yeah, they used to come and go as they pleased.

You must be sick of those guys.

It was such a long time to be together, and it was such a physically hard show, that we were all very fatigued and the slightest thing would set you off, when in real life it wouldn't have bothered us. We asked the crew to lock up before they left. Sometimes we'd come home and the front door was open. We're like, "We do live here, you know."

Were you worried about what the cameras would see?

That preyed the most on my mind. It was one of my biggest worries.

You thought they were going to film you showering or something?

When I got to the clause that said there would be hidden cameras, and they could get you naked, I made sure they put a big cross through that one and signed it off.

So we won't see you naked in this series?

No way. I kept my babies under wraps for the show. I didn't want them to take over the whole program [laughs]. I kept that renovating gear on the whole time.

But your breasts have already been mentioned, haven't they?

I didn't realise the extent of it until towards the end of the show. Everyone, including journalists, were talking about them.

And not your renovation skills?

I'd done a little bit of modelling before, but I didn't mention it because I wanted to be on the program for our renovating. So I tried to keep the things under wraps.
