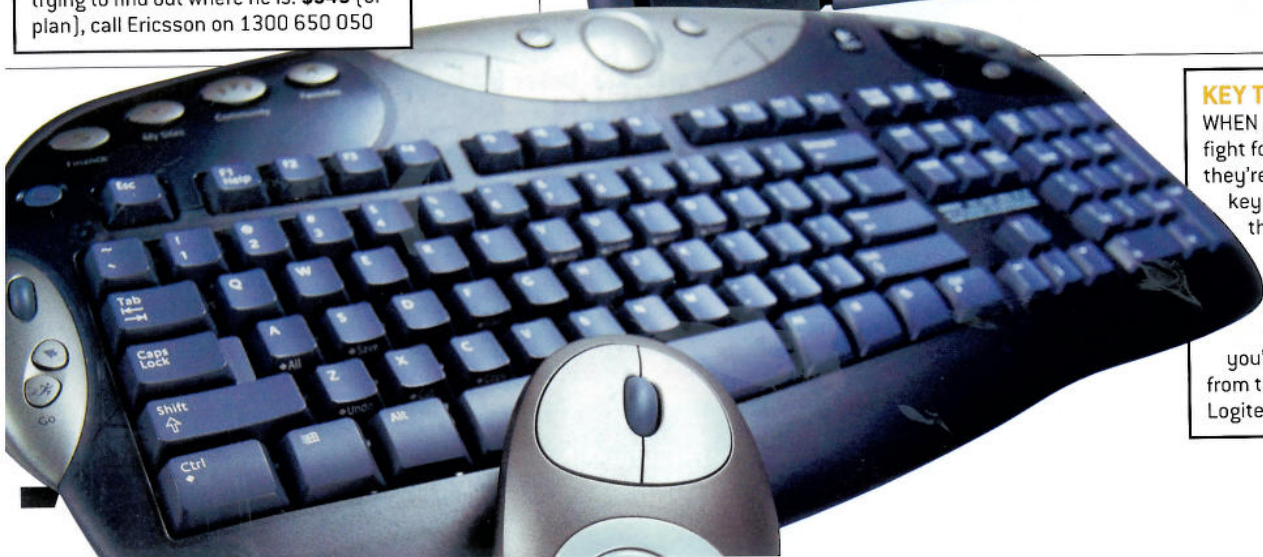
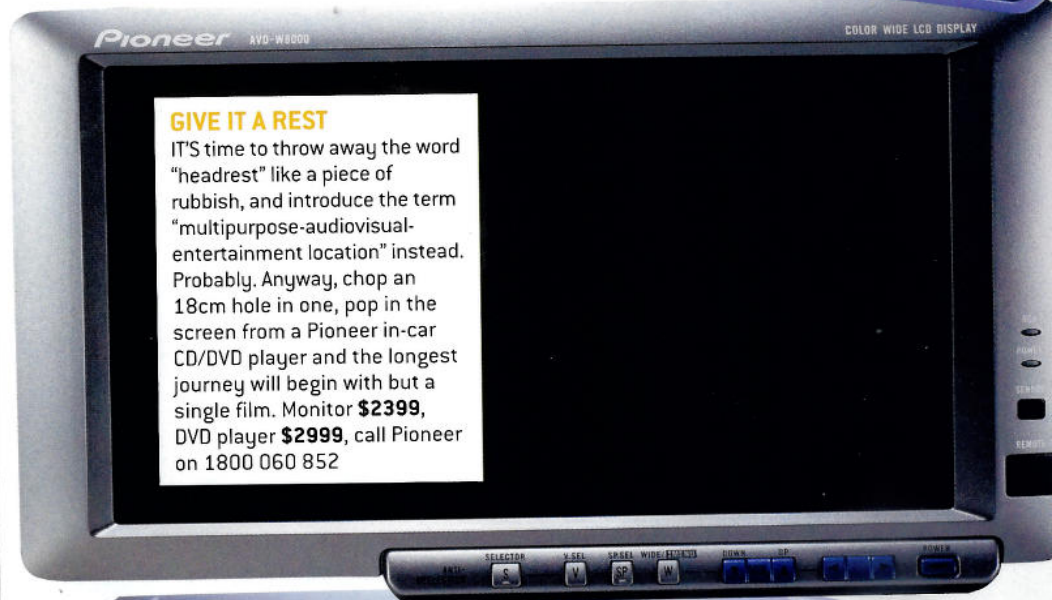


### SCREENED CALLS
